The purpose of the TAP grant is to provide and administer \$50,000 of TVA's funds to be used by a qualified community group to hire independent technical advisors during the response activities performed to address the mid-term and longer-term strategic site objectives as identified in the Administrative Order and Agreement on Consent (AOC).
